All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the improvements thereon situate, lying  
and being in the Poinsett Mill Community of Greater Greenville, County of Greenville,  
and State of South Carolina, located on the East side of Wilson Terrace, being more fully  
described as follows:

BEGINNING at a three-fourths (3/4) inch steel rod (old mark) situated on the East right-of-  
way line of said Wilson Terrace and being the westerly property corner of School District
