ORDER AUTHORIZING DEBTOR IN POSSESSION TO SELL ASSETS

At Wilson, North Carolina, this 7th day of July 1981.

Upon Complaint of Westboro Corporation, Debtor in Possession, filed May 1, 1981, seeking authority to sell assets pursuant to Section 363(b) of the Bankruptcy Code and to transfer liens to proceeds of sale (the "Complaint") and upon the Answers filed in response to the Complaint, the Court finds:

1.

That Westboro Corporation filed a voluntary petition seeking relief under Chapter 11 of Title XI of the United States Code on December 19, 1979. On the same date, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of North Carolina entered an Order authorizing Westboro Corporation as a Debtor in Possession to continue operation of its business, said Order being recorded in Deed Book 1118, Page 845, Greenville County, South Carolina, RMC Office.

2.

That the Debtor in Possession has been unable to find any purchasers for the business of the Debtor corporation as a going concern and that the only means of adequately protecting the creditors is to liquidate the various assets owned by the Debtor corporation at the best price obtainable.
