

(j) To receive any checks, drafts, or any other monies, in any form, from any person or persons or source, including Social Security checks and to endorse the same and deposit the same in the account of the attorney-in-fact, and to withdraw and use the same for any and all purposes as my said attorney-in-fact deems advisable; she to have the sole discretion as to the amount expended or for what purpose.

(k) My said attorney-in-fact shall have the power to inventory or remove anything she so desires from any safe deposit box or boxes, which I may have, and this is the authority to the bank or institution in which any lock box is located, to allow her to invade the same.

(l) To vote any stock that I might have in any corporation and to transfer said stock or bonds if she deems it advisable, giving her the sole discretion in this matter.

(m) Without, in anywise, limiting the foregoing, it is my intention for my attorney-in-fact, Pearle W. London, to have the power to generally do, execute and perform any other act, deed, matter or thing whatsoever that ought to be done, executed and performed, or that, in the opinion of my said attorney, ought to be done, executed or performed, in and about the premises, of every nature and kind whatsoever, as fully and effectually as I could do if personally present.

And I, the said EMMA W. WARDLAW, do hereby ratify and confirm all whatsoever that my said attorney-in-fact, Pearle W. London, or her substitute or substitutes, shall do or cause to be done, in or about the premises by virtue of this Power of Attorney.
