the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto
Danny Charles Crawford, his heirs and assigns:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown and designated as Lot No. 29, on plat of Westwood Terrace, formerly Cedar Lane Gardens, which plat is recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "GG", page 139 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the northern side of Jonquil Lane at the joint front corner of Lots 29 and 30, which point is 241 feet from the intersection of said Lane and Orchid Drive, and running from the intersection of said Lane and Orchid Drive, and running thence N. 51-21 E. 158.9 feet to a point; thence S. 38-09 E. 75 feet to a point; thence S. 49-51 W. 155.1 feet to a point on Jonquil Lane; thence with said Lane, N. 40-57 W. 80 feet to the point of BEGINNING.

As a part of the consideration for this conveyance, the Grantee herein assumes and agrees to pay that certain mortgage held by Administrator of Veterans Affairs in the original amount of \$12,150.00 recorded December 28, 1959 in volume 812, page 215 in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C. on which there is an approximate balance of \$6,000.00.
