AGREEMENT BY CITY OF GREENVILLE
FOR PARK AND RECREATIONAL USE

WHEREAS, the City of Greenville is the owner of all those certain three tracts of land being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, state of South Carolina, known as "Cleveland Park," "Mayberry Park," and "Holmes Park," and being more fully described herein.

WHEREAS, the City of Greenville uses this property as a portion of its Parks and Recreation System, and the City of Greenville has received a federal grant provided by the Heritage Conservation and Recreation Service of the Department of the Interior in accordance with the Urban Park and Recreation Recovery Act of 1978 (Title X, Public Law 95-625).

Pursuant to a requirement of that law, this property may not be converted to other than public outdoor recreation uses (whether by transfer, sale, or in any other manner) without the express written approval of the Secretary of the Interior. By law, the Secretary shall approve such conversion only if he finds it to be in accord with the then existing comprehensive statewide outdoor recreation plan and only upon such conditions as he deems necessary to assure the substitution of other recreation properties of at least equal fair market value and of reasonably equivalent usefulness and location.
