7. To appear, answer, and defend in all actions and suits whatsoever which shall be commenced against me and also for me and in my name to compromise, settle, and adjust, with each and every person or persons, all actions, accounts, dues, and demands, subsisting or to subsist between me and them or any of them, and in such manner as my said attorney-in-fact shall think proper; hereby giving to my said attorney power and authority to do, execute, and perform and finish for me and in my name all those things which shall be expedient and necessary, or which my said attorney shall judge expedient and necessary in and about or concerning the premises, or any of them, as fully as I, the said Bradley R. Johnson could do if personally present, hereby ratifying and confirming whatever my said attorney shall do or cause to be done in, about, or concerning the premises, and any part thereof.

This instrument is to be construed and interpreted as a general power of attorney. The enumeration of specific items, rights, acts, or powers herein is not intended to, nor does it, limit or restrict, and is not to be construed or interpreted as limiting or restricting, the general powers herein granted to said attorney-in-fact.

The rights, powers, and authority of said attorney-in-fact granted in this instrument shall commence and be in full force and effect as of the date of execution hereof, and such rights, powers, and authority shall remain in full force and effect thereafter until I, Bradley R. Johnson, give notice in writing that such power is terminated. This power of attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal which renders the principal incapable of managing his own estate.
