WHEREAS, the owner of Lot 77 is selling Lot 77 this date to Gordon Lee and Ellen F. Culler, and

WHEREAS, owners' and mortgage title insurance on said Lot 77 is being written on said Lot 77 insuring both Gordon Lee and Ellen F. Culler and South Carolina Federal Savings and Loan Association, and

WHEREAS, the owners of Lots 78 and 92 agree by this document to not require that said fence encroachment be removed at this time so as to allow Gordon Lee and Ellen F. Culler to receive owners, and mortgages title insurance on Lot ?? free of exception on account of said encroachment of said fence on Lot 78 and Lot 92.

Now, THEREFORE in consideration of ten (\$10.00) dollars in hand paid by the owner of Lot 77 to the owners of Lots 78 and 92 it is agreed as follows:
