

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Julian Arnold Rowland, a resident of the County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, being desirous of appointing an attorney-in-fact to act for me and on my behalf in all matters in which I now or hereafter may have an interest, do by these presents, constitute, make and appoint Susan J. Rowland of Greenville, South Carolina my true and lawful attorney-in-fact for me and in my name and stead, and to my use, to take, hold, and manage all my business of any and all natures and kinds, including the right to draw checks upon my bank account or bank accounts; to borrow money in my name; to purchase or convey real estate and personal property, and to mortgage the same; to collect debts and accounts due me; to pay any debts or claims due by me; and to do any and all other things and acts incidental to or convenient to the management of my business affairs and personal affairs as fully as I could do if personally present, with full power of substitution and revocation, and I do hereby ratify and confirm all that my said attorney or substitute shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue hereof.

This power of attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal which renders the principal incapable of managing his own estate.
