CANCELLATION OF CONTRACT FOR DEED

This Agreement made and entered into the Africa day of July, 1982, by and between H. Frank Poston, Virginia M. Poston, hereinafter called Sellers and Ruth Bertling, hereinafter called Buyer.

WHEREAS, said parties have agreed by and between themselves to cancel said Contract for Deed and to render it null and void and to further authorize the Register of Mesne Conveyance for the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina to cancel said Contract for Deed of record.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration and in further consideration of the within premises the parties hereby agree as follows:

- (1) That all parties agree that the Contract for Deed is cancelled and duly authorize the Register of Mesne Conveyance to cancel said Contract for Deed of record;
- (2) That all sums heretofore paid by the Buyer to the Sellers are forfeited to the Sellers as liquidated damages;
- (3) That both the Sellers and the Buyer mutually release each and the other from any liability resulting from the execution of this Contract for deed.
