

(7) In addition to the above powers, also such other incidental powers to act as may be necessary or proper for the execution of the powers above granted.

This Power of Attorney shall remain in full force and effect until revoked by me, and possession of the original of this document by my said agent shall be sufficient and conclusive evidence that this Power of Attorney has not been revoked, and furthermore,

This power of attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of me which renders me incapable of managing my own estate, thus
