

(8) To have access to such safety deposit box as may be leased by me.

(9) And, generally, to manage and control my property and to execute any and all instruments necessary or expedient for that purpose as I might do, if personally present.

And I, the said OTTO E. PETERS, JR., do hereby ratify and confirm all acts of my attorney, and do declare that all acts and deeds performed under this instrument shall have the same full force and effect as if performed and signed by me in person, and this instrument shall be effective until revoked in writing or shall cease by operation of law.

Notwithstanding any other provision herein to the contrary, my attorney shall have no power or authority whatsoever over any policy of life insurance owned by me which insures the life of my attorney.

This Power of Attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal which renders the principal incapable of managing his own estate.
