The rights, powers, and authority of said attorney in fact herein granted shall commence and be in full force and effect on June 23, 1982, and such rights, powers and authority shall remain in full force and effect thereafter until cancelled by me in writing. No cancellation shall be effective as to any person relying on this power or attorney unless such person has received actual notice of its cancellation; except as to any transaction by my attorney in fact involving my real estate record notice, filed in the County in which said real estate is situate, shall take the place of actual notice. This power of attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal which renders the principal incapable of managing his own estate.
