GREER, whose address is 200 Hammett Bridge Road, Greer, SC 29651, my Attorney-in-Fact for me and in my name, place and stead to do and perform all acts, deeds, matters and things whatsoever concerning my property and personal affairs necessary and advisable in the judgment of my said Attorney-in-Fact as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as I could do if personally present and acting, including but not limited to, each and every one of the following matters:

1. Dealing in Property: To buy, receive, lease, accept, or otherwise acquire; to sell, convey, mortgage, hypothecate, pledge, quit claim, or otherwise encumber or dispose of; or to contract or agree for the acquisition, disposal, or encumbrance of any property whatsoever or any custody, possession, interest, or right therein, upon such terms, considerations, and conditions as my said attorney shall think proper;
2.
