Mack Hendrix as her heirs at law as reflected in the Greenville County Probate Court in Apartment 1157, File 10. At the time of her death, she was the sole owner of subject real estate. J. Mack Hendrix was the husband of Lula T. Hendrix and inherited a one-third interest in subject real estate at the time of her death. J. Mack Hendrix died testate in Greenville County on February 26, 1980, leaving Ralph W. Hendrix and Defendants his one-third interest in subject property as reflected in the Greenville County Probate Court in Apartment 1620, File 15.
