GENERAL POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT I, Vivian Brown Chapman presently residing at 49 Aberdeen Drive, Greenville, South Carolina (hereinafter referred to as the "principal"), do hereby constitute and appoint my son, George Leroy Robbins, presently residing at 1805 Hudson Road, Greer, S. To demand, sue for, collect and receive all rents, dividends, interest, proceeds for sale, and any and all other funds or property, of every kind and nature whatsoever, which may be due or become due to me, and to deliver such releases, receipts, satisfactions and other discharges which my said attorney may deem necessary or proper.
