

fence will have three strands of barbed wire, which will extend across the easement and connect on the east with an existing four (4) foot fence and then approximately one hundred twenty (120) feet westerly to an existing four (4) foot cyclone fence.

It is specifically understood that the Grantee may, at its election, open the fence to its property for ingress and egress, but nothing would prohibit the Grantors from using the twenty (20) foot strip of land of the Grantee up to the fence for ingress and egress to the Grantors' property.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the easements, rights and privileges abovementioned unto Grantee, its successors and assigns, forever.
