

- (o) To employ nurses and doctors, domestic workers, agents and others and to remove them and to appoint others in their places, and to pay and allow to them for their services such salaries, wages or other remuneration as my attorney shall deem proper.
- (p) To make any reports of information of any sort whatsoever to any government as required by law or regulation.
- (q) To open and have free access to any lockbox to which I may have access, and to all the contents thereof.
- (r) To prepare, execute, verify and file in my name and on my behalf any and all types of tax returns, amended returns, declarations of estimated tax, report, protest, application for correction of assessed evaluation of real or other property, appeal, brief, claim for refund, or petition to any Court in connection with any tax imposed or purported to be imposed by any government, or claim, levied or assessed by any government, and to pay any such tax or enter any agreement, obtain any extension or take any action my said attorney shall deem proper.
- (s) I hereby expressly waive any requirement that any transfer by my said attorney to or for the benefit of my said attorney of any of my property, personal or real, shall be for a fair market value.

This power of attorney shall not be affected by the subsequent disability or incompetence of the principal, which renders the principal incapable of managing his own estate.

Without in any wise limiting the foregoing, generally to do, execute and perform any other act, deed, matter or thing whatsoever, that ought to be done, executed and performed, or that, in the opinion of my said attorney ought to be done, executed or performed in and about the premises, of every nature and kind whatsoever, as fully effectual as I could do if personally present.

And I do hereby ratify and confirm all whatsoever that my said attorney or his substitute or substitutes, shall do, or cause to be done, in or about the premises, by virtue of this power of attorney.

This instrument may not be changed orally.
