KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That I, JOSEPH E. CAMPBELL, have constituted, made and appointed and BY THESE PRESENTS do hereby constitute, make and appoint CHARLES E. BRADSHAW my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name and stead to take and hold possession of and to deal with all of my estate, real, personal and mixed, whether now owned by me or hereafter acquired by me. In such capacity my said attorney shall have all of the powers of a general agent, including, without limitation on the foregoing, the following powers:

To sell for cash or on such terms as he may deem in his own discretion proper any real or personal property owned by me;

To lease or mortgage or pledge any of such property on such terms as he, in his discretion, may deem proper;

To draw upon all bank accounts and accounts in other financial institutions standing in my name;

To sign and endorse any character of negotiable instrument and to deposit the proceeds of the same in my name subject to withdrawal by him;

To borrow money and to secure the same by any of my property, real, personal or mixed, and to enter into such contracts or other obligations as he may deem necessary for the improvement or preservation of any part of my said property;

To institute and defend in my name any character of litigation, at law or in equity;

To compromise debts due me or other liabilities to me and to pay, settle and compromise on such terms as he may deem proper any liabilities on my part or that may arise in respect to any part of my estate;

To execute in my name deeds, mortgages, leases, releases, satisfactions and any other character of instrument that may be necessary or desirable in connection with the execution of any of the powers herein granted, and, in general,

To do any and all such things as I could do if personally present in relation to any matter or thing connected with my estate, hereby ratifying and confirming everything that my said attorney may do in my name on or after the date hereof.

This Power of Attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence which renders me incapable of managing my own estate, and the authority conferred by this Power shall be exercisable notwithstanding my later disability or mental incompetence, and any acts of my at-
