KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that we, HAZEL R. GORDON and HARRISON REVIS, of Henderson County, North Carolina, as Grantors in consideration of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) and other valuable considerations to the Grantors in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the Grantees (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto HARRISON REVIS and wife, EDNA REVIS, as Joint Tenants with Right of Survivorship, of 1609 Old Spartanburg Road, Hendersonville, North Carolina 28739, in Henderson County, as Grantees and their heirs and assigns, forever, all of the following described real estate located in O'Neal Township, Greenville County, South Carolina:

Containing 19.75 acres, more or less, and being the same lands which were conveyed to C.I. Willis by J.E. Gibson by deed dated December 15, 1919, and to C.I. Willis by W.L. Westmoreland by deed dated November 20, 1919, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 57, Pages 265 and 268 respectively and more particularly described in those deeds, reference to which is hereby made. Reference is also made to plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book E, Page 183, and to deed to W.B. Revis recorded in Book 522, Page 406.

W.B. Revis died intestate in Henderson County, North Carolina, on December 13, 1969 survived by his widow, Daisy O. Revis, and his son and daughter, Harrison Revis and Hazel R. Gordon. Daisy O. Revis died December 19, 1982 and by her Last Will, now of record in the Probate Court for Greenville County, devised her entire estate to Hazel R. Gordon and Harrison Revis.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the Grantees hereinabove named, and their heirs and assigns forever.

And the Grantors do hereby bind the Grantors and their heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Grantees hereinabove named, and their heirs and assigns against the Grantors and their heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
