the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto HATTIE RUTH ADAMS CLARK, her heirs and assigns, all my right, title and interest in and to, ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, beginning at an iron pin on Green Avenue, Lynch's corner; thence with said Lynch's line, N. 73 1/4 W. 140 feet to a stake 3 X in back line; thence S. 20 W. with James Miles line 44 feet to an iron pin; thence in a line parallel with said line of Wm. Lynch to an iron pin on Green Avenue, 54 feet from said Lynch corner, or beginning; thence with Green Avenue 54 feet to the beginning.

This is the same property conveyed to Dicey Adams by deed of John Sullivan and Annie Hawkins recorded on April 29, 1930 in Deed Book 152 at Page 205 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County. The said Dicey Adams died testate as a resident of Greenville County on January 15, 1963, devising the above-captioned property to Eunice Adams as will appear according to Item 2 of Dicey Adams' Last Will and Testament. The above-described property is also known as 504 Green Avenue, Greenville, South Carolina. Reference is made to Apartment 825 at File 14 in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County. The said Eunice Adams died intestate as a resident of Greenville County on January 28, 1983 leaving as her sole heirs at law her sister Clarice Stewart, her brother E. Melvin Adams, her brother Paul Adams, her sister Hattie Ruth Adams Clark, and her niece Ira A. Page who is the only child of a pre-deceased brother, Franklin Adams. All of the above-mentioned are brothers and sisters of the whole blood and Eunice Adams also had brothers and sisters of the half blood, but under the South Carolina statute of dissent and distribution said brothers and sisters of the half blood did not inherit any interest in the assets of the Eunice Adams Estate.
