the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto FAYE CHILDRESS, her heirs and assigns, forever:

A right-of-way and/or easement for ingress and egress on and over properties owned by the grantors described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southeastern corner of property owned by Faye Childress and being the joint corner of property owned by A. C. Thompson and Edister M. Thompson, and running with the joint line of said property N. 23-29 W. 15 feet to a new point; thence S. 65-54 W. 866 feet to a point on Dunklin Bridge Road; thence in an easterly direction along and with Dunklin Bridge Road to an iron pin, the corner of property now owned by A. C. Thompson; thence N. 65-54 E. 866 feet to the point of beginning.

This being a portion of the property conveyed to the Grantors Thompson in a deed executed by Sammy K. Stallings on May 17, 1969, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deeds Volume 868 at page 207 and as to the Grantor Storay a portion of the right-of-way for ingress and egress executed on June 26, 1979, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County Deeds Volume 1105 at page 683.
