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(24) This Power of Attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal which renders the principal incapable of managing her own estate. It is my intention that the authority conferred herein shall be exercisable notwithstanding my physical disability or mental incompetence.

(25) I do hereby make, constitute and appoint my daughter, MARY LYLETE CRAWFORD MONAHAN, as standby attorney. If, for any reason, my son, ROBERT L. CRAWFORD, JR., is incapable, either temporarily or permanently, of performing as my lawful attorney, then my daughter, MARY LYLETE CRAWFORD MONAHAN, as standby attorney, shall so serve as my true and lawful attorney with all the powers herein granted.
