TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Willie Elrod Ayers and Charlotte Denny Ayers, their Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said Willie Elrod Ayers and Charlotte Denny Ayers,

their Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
