ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in Check Springs Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being known and designated as on the Northeastern side of Worley Road and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeastern side of Worley Road, which point is 200 feet, more or less, Northwest from B.
