It is understood by and between the parties herein that the Grantees shall construct the drainage and/or sewer pipelines on the minimum grade approved by the City Engineering Department for the City of Greenville. It is understood by and between the parties herein that the Grantor shall not permit the portion of the above described property of the Grantor designated as easements "A" through "E" and slope easement on the attached plat to be recorded herewith to be used for any purposes which would conflict with the purposes for which this easement was granted.

This permanent easement and right-of-way is given for the use and benefit of the property of the Grantees herein and this Grant shall be deemed to be appurtenant to and run with the land and inure to the Grantees, their heirs, successors and assigns.
