estate. In connection with these powers, my attorney-in-fact is empowered to enter into new leases for any term, and to sell, convey, or mortgage any real estate affected by these presents.

- (5) the power to constitute, appoint, and authorize in my attorney-in-fact's place and stead with full power of revocation, other attorneys-in-fact for me, to exercise any or all of the powers granted to my attorney-in-fact by these presents.
- (6) the power to do all of that which I could do if I were personally present.

THIS POWER OF ATTORNEY SHALL NOT BE AFFECTED BY PHYSICAL DISABILITY OR MENTAL INCOMPETENCE OF THE PRINCIPAL WHICH RENDERS THE PRINCIPAL INCAPABLE OF MANAGING HIS OWN ESTATE.
