meeting, shall be by the same person authorized to cast the vote of such member if in an Association meeting.

- K. Adjourned Meetings. If any meetings of members cannot be organized because a quorum has not attended, the members who are present, either in person or by proxy, may adjourn the meeting from time to time until a quorum is present.
- L. <u>Presiding Officer</u>. The presiding officer at all meetings shall be the President, in whose absence the Vice-President shall preside. If neither such officer is present, the members shall elect a chairman to preside at the particular meeting.
- M. Order of Business. The order of business at annual meetings of members, and, as far as practical at all other meetings of members, shall be:
 - 1. Calling of the roll and certifying of proxies.
 - 2. Proof of notice of meeting or waiver of notice.
 - 3. Reading and disposal of any unapproved minutes.
 - 4. Reports of officers.
 - 5. Reports of committees.
 - 6. Election of directors.
 - 7. Unfinished business.
 - 8. New business.
 - Adjournment.
- N. Powers and Duties of Members. Powers and duties of members shall be those powers and duties specifically and exclusively required by the Declaration and these By-Laws to be exercised and to be performed by the Association, which powers and duties shall be exercised and performed upon a majority of the total vote of the Association, except as otherwise provided in, the Declaration or these By-Laws, such powers and duties to include, but not be limited to, the following:
 - 1. Election of directors, as provided in these By-Laws.
