do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Furman University, its successors and assigns forever:

All that certain lot or parcel of land situate in the City of Greenville and in the County and State aforesaid on the south side of Washington Street and measuring fifty-five feet on Washington Street and running back one hundred and fifty-five feet being a parallelogram in shape represented on a plat of the W. T. Shumate lands as Lot No. 2.
