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Naomi Strong testified in her behalf and no other witnesses were put up by the defendant.

This matter arose out of a dispute over the title to a piece of property located on Odessa Street in Greenville County, South Carolina, more particularly described in that certain deed recorded on November 11, 1952, in the Greenville County RMC Office in Deed Book 466, Page 376. Summons, Complaint and Lis Pendens were ^{filed} on September 29, 1982 and duly served on the defendant on October 4, 1982. An Answer, dated October 29, 1982, was filed by the defendant and duly served thereafter.

The plaintiffs' Complaint alleged that the defendant had wrongfully obtained title to the property in question and sought an Order re-establishing title to the same in the name of the plaintiff church, and for other relief, such as an accounting of all proceeds, retraining order and delivery to the plaintiffs all church documents in defendant's possession. The defendant's Answer basically denied the material allegations of the Complaint and alleged that the defendant, rather than the plaintiffs, was the proper authority of the church and title holder to the property in question.
