

Naomi Strong also testified that the Church on or near the subject property is in actuality MTPC, but that the plaintiffs' wrongfully took it over and changed the name to St. James. It was her position that the MTPC is only the local church, that the local church is not a part of the plaintiffs' movement, and that she, as Chairman of the Board of the local church, had authority to make the 1980 conveyance. She further testified that John Strong, Jr., and Claudette Swinton and herself are the duly elected Trustees of "MTPC" and comprise the entire Board of Trustees thereof.

After having heard the testimony in this matter, and reviewed and considered the pleadings, exhibits and deposition, this Court finds, by clear and convincing evidence, the following facts and makes the following conclusions of law:

1. That the MTPC is the general body which is composed of three districts and eleven churches, including the St. James Church located at or near the property which is the subject of this action.
