federal, county, city or other, and to obtain, make claim upon, collect and dispose of insurance and insurance proceeds for my care, custody and or control;

12. To prepare, execute and file all joint or separate tax, social security, unemployment insurance and other returns, for any years, required by the laws of the United States, or of any state or subdivision thereof; and to pay, compromise, contest or apply for and receive refunds in connection with any taxes or assessments for which I am or may be liable, or to make any tax election;

13. To employ, discharge and compensate medical personnel including physicians, surgeons, dentists, medical specialists, nurses, and/or paramedical assistants deemed by Attorney needful or appropriate for the proper care, custody and control of my person; to make all necessary arrangements, contractual or otherwise, for me at any hospital, nursing home, convalescent home, or similar establishment; to authorize and consent to any and all kinds of medical procedures and treatment including but not limited to medication, therapy, surgery, and dental care;

14. To make advance arrangements for funeral services, burial plot and marker, and other related goods and services as my Attorney deems appropriate.

ARTICLE II.

Termination, Amendment, Resignation and Removal
