KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that We, Stephen Max Foster, Deborah Hindman (formerly Deborah Crisp), Patricia Raines (formerly Patricia Foster), Cathy Miller, and Ann Wardell

in consideration of One (\$1.00) Dollar Love and Affection----- Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Stephen Max Foster and Michael T. George, their heirs and assigns forever;

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, and being known and designated as Lots 51 and 52 of a subdivision of the property of H. J. Haynsworth known as Sans Souci Highlands as shown on plat thereof as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Books C, page 71, G, page 126, and also L, page 173, less that portion conveyed to J. A. Hart and shown on Block Book at Sheet 171, Block 3, Lot 12.1.

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southeast corner of Sunshine Avenue and Club Road (sometimes referred to as Bird Avenue), and running thence along the south side of Club Road S. 68-30 E. 154 feet to a stake; thence S. 22-38 W. 100 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 52 and 53; thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 68-30 W. 154 feet to the joint corner of said lots on the southeast side of Sunshine Avenue; thence along the line of said Sunshine Avenue N. 22-38 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.

This is that property conveyed to Max H. Foster and Catherine S. Foster by deed of Consuelo S. Williams by deed recorded July 8, 1952 in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 459 at Page 7. Both Max H. Foster and Catherine S.
