

3. Resignation, Revocation and Removal

(a) This power of attorney shall remain in full force and effect until the earlier of the following events:

(i) I have revoked this special power of attorney by written instrument recorded in the public records of the county aforesaid; or

(ii) A committee shall have been appointed for me by a court of competent jurisdiction.

(b) Any Attorney-in-fact named herein may resign by delivering to me in writing a copy of such resignation and recording the original in the public records of the county aforesaid. Upon such resignation and recording, Attorney shall thereafter be divested of all authority under this special power of attorney.

(c) Any Attorney herein may be removed by written instrument executed by me and recorded in the public records of the county aforesaid.

4. Incidental Powers and Binding Effect

(a) The powers herein conferred may be exercised by Attorney and the signature or act of Attorney on my behalf may be accepted by third persons as fully authorized by me and with the same force and effect as if done under my hand and seal and as if I were present in person, acting on my own behalf and competent. No person who may act in reliance upon the representations of Attorney for the authority granted to Attorney shall incur any liability to me or to my estate as a result of permitting Attorney to exercise any power. I do hereby ratify and confirm each and every act which Attorney shall and may do by virtue hereof.

(b) The invalidity of any provision or part of this special power of attorney shall not affect the validity of any other provision or part hereof.

5. Exoneration of Attorney and Others

On behalf of myself, my heirs, assigns, executors and administrators, I hereby release and forever discharge:
