

of whatever nature and however arising shall not in any manner limit any of the powers herein conferred upon my Attorney and he may perform any act which he is authorized to perform under this Power of Attorney, notwithstanding any such conflict of interest. I do hereby ratify and confirm all things so done by my said Attorney, within the scope of the authority herein given, as fully and to the same extent as if by me personally done and performed.

(24) This Power of Attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal which renders the principal incapable of managing her own estate. It is my intention that the authority conferred herein shall be exercisable notwithstanding my physical disability or mental incompetence.

(25) I do hereby make, constitute and appoint the wife of my son, MARGARET K. CANNON, as standby attorney. If for any reason my son, MARVIN P. CANNON, JR., is incapable, either temporarily or permanently, of performing as my lawful attorney, then the wife of my son, MARGARET K. CANNON, as standby attorney, shall so serve as my true and lawful attorney with all the powers herein granted.
