This Power of Attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal, which renders the principal incapable of managing his own estate and anyone dealing with my said attorney may rely fully and completely upon the executed original or any executed copy of this power of attorney or upon any record of the same recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County until actual receipt of written notice signed by me of its revocation or until actual receipt of notice of my death.
