means of a written instrument recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County), and may be exercised concurrently or separately by the holder(s) thereof.

In the event L. Stewart Spinks has not assigned his rights of enforcement during said ten (10) year period and he dies, then and in such event the rights of enforcement shall pass to his heirs at law if he dies intestate. In the event he should die testate, the rights of enforcement shall pass to any party designated in his Will to receive said rights of enforcement provided the Will is probated in the Greenville County Court House. In the event Spinx Oil Company, Inc. shall cease to be a corporation in good standing according to the records of the Office of the Secretary of State of South Carolina during said ten (10) year period, all rights of enforcement as to Spinx Oil Company, Inc. shall cease.

In the event L. Stewart Spinks or Spinx Oil Company, Inc. should assign the rights of enforcement through a written assignment recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County during said ten (10) year period, the assignee of said rights of enforcement shall have all rights granted to L. Stewart Spinks and Spinx Oil Company, Inc. in this paragraph 2, unless limited by the terms of the recorded assignment.

The purpose of this paragraph is to provide the identity of the parties having the rights to enforce the said restrictions. It is the desire of the Declarants that the identities of the parties having rights of enforcement can be determined from the public records in the Greenville County Court House.

In the event the parties having rights to enforce the restrictions desire to terminate the same prior to the end of said ten (10) year period, a document stating that the said restrictions are terminated, signed by all
