

agreements, mortgages, receipts, notes, evidences of indebtedness and any releases and satisfactions of mortgages, judgments and other debts and such other written instruments of whatever kind and nature as may be necessary or proper under the particular circumstances.

Thus giving and granting unto my said attorney the full power and authority to do and perform any and all acts whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done in the handling of my business affairs as fully and completely as I might do were I conducting said business affairs in a personal capacity, I nevertheless retain the right to revoke this Power of Attorney by the filing of a written revocation duly recorded in the R.M.C. Office for the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina; however, this Power of Attorney shall not be affected by any physical disability or mental incapacity which may render me incapable of managing my own estate but shall survive the same and remain in full force and effect until duly revoked as provided herein.
