

S. 83-48 E. 94.88 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 83-53 E. 131.05 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 13-08 E. 193.7 feet to an iron pin; the directions, metes and bounds set forth which run along the road or roads outlined on the plat filed in this matter are intended to run along the center line of those roads, the iron pin at which we have now arrived is intended to be where the center line of the road passes over the Pacolet River. The line then runs along with the Pacolet River at approximately the following direction; thence S. 75-10 E. 127.74 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 37-09 E. 135.81 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 86-19 E. 342.97 feet to the point of beginning.

This property is the north and northeast tract of two tracts of land each being 72 and 93/100 acres as described on the plat for Lloyd and Floyd Plumley prepared by Webb Surveying and Mapping Company, May, 1984, and filed in Plat Book 10 T at Page 19. This plat describes the property the Master-in-Equity decided belonged to Floyd and Helen Plumley in Case No. 82-CP-23-129, Lloyd and Evia Plumley vs. Floyd and Helen Plumley and Judgment Roll No. 84-493.
