- 5. The parties agree that there is no attempt to adversely possess the property but rather the location of the fence is an accommodation to the Crabtree's granted by the Hughes'.
- 6. It is understood between the parties that that portion of fence located on the Hughes' property shall remain on the property of the Crabtrees' and the maintenance of said fence shall be at the discretion of the
- 7. This Agreement is binding on the heirs, successors, and assigns of the parties.
