

point also being denoted as a black gum at a creek and old fence on the plat; thence S. 72-30 E. 178.03 feet to a point also marked as a spring; thence N. 65-18 E. 84.21 feet to a point; thence S. 57-22 E. 328.4 feet to a point; thence S. 70-15 E. 131.08 feet to a point; thence S. 12-08 W. 61.7 feet to a point; thence S. 51-20 W. 58.67 feet to a point also denoted as an iron pin at a black gum; thence S. 86-19 E. 819.58 feet to a point; thence N. 8-54 W. 329.06 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the southwest tract of the two tracts of land each being 72 and 93/100 acres as described on the plat for Lloyd Plumley and Floyd Plumley. This plat is filed at Book 10 T, at Page 19 and describes the property the Master-in-Equity has decreed belonged to Lloyd and Evia Plumley in the Case No. 82-CP-23-129, Lloyd and Evia Plumley vs. Floyd and Helen Plumley and Judgment Roll No. 84-493.
