KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, W. S. FARMER, JR.

in consideration of EIGHT THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED and No/100--(\$8,500.00)----- Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto WILLIAM R. ALEXANDER and JUDY Y. ALEXANDER, their heirs and assigns forever:

ALL my right, title and interest, the same being an undivided one-fourth (1/4) interest, in and to the following described property:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, at the intersection of West Lee Road and Pine Knoll Drive, being shown on a plat by Freeland & Associates dated July 16, 1984, entitled "Property of William R. Alexander and Judy Y. Alexander", recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 10-4 at Page 45, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the intersection of West Lee Road and Pine Knoll Drive, and running thence along the southern side of West Lee Road, S. 73-34 E. 155.0 feet to an iron pin; thence running S. 00-18 W. 175.65 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 79-05 W. 197.68 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Pine Knoll Drive; thence running along the eastern side of Pine Knoll Drive, N. 01-39 E. 165.0 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of West Lee Road and Pine Knoll Drive; thence with the curve of said intersection, the chord of which is N. 67-37 E. 45.0 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

This is the same property conveyed to W. S. Farmer by deed of Henry P. McGee dated March 21, 1923 and recorded February 25, 1924 in Greenville County Deed Book 83 at Page 120, and by deed of T. M. Groce to W. S. Farmer dated March 20, 1936 and recorded April 3, 1936, in Greenville County Deed Book 184 at Page 253. W. S. Farmer thereafter died testate at Greenville County, South Carolina on July 7, 1978, having been predeceased by his wife, Sarah Brown Farmer, and leaving as his sole beneficiaries his four children, Helen F. Sweat, George P. Farmer, James M. Farmer and W. S. Farmer, Jr. Thereafter James M. Farmer died

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together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s), and the grantee(s)'s heirs or successors and assigns, forever. And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor(s)'s heirs or successors, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular said premises unto the grantee(s) and the grantee(s)'s heirs or successors and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
