

ditions of any permits or agreements concerning this project and any and all lands and waters involved therewith.

This Easement may be terminated by the STATE, in its discretion, and such interests as the STATE may have shall revert to the STATE if GREENVILLE TEC, its successors and assigns:

- (1) quits and abandons all use of such intake structure and pump station, in which case this Easement of right-of-way shall terminate thirty (30) days after the date of such abandonment; or
- (2) continues an uncorrected violation or breach of any of the terms and conditions herein, provided further, it is understood and agreed that this Easement is not to be construed as an Easement granted to the exclusion of the STATE, or to others later granted a similar right.
