ALL the undivided right, title and interest of the grantor or grantors in and to the following described property:

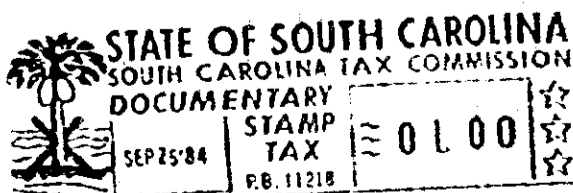

The said Fred Burgess Hemphill died intestate in 1982 survived by his mother, Annie Hemphill, and twenty other heirs at law, consisting of brothers and sisters and nieces and nephews, as will appear by reference to Apartment 1736, File 9, in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County. The said Annie Hemphill died testate on January 17, 1983, as appears by reference to Apartment 1741, File 24, in the Office of the Greenville County Probate Court and the devisees under the Will of Annie Hemphill consisted of the aforesaid twenty heirs at law of Fred Burgess Hemphill. The grantor or grantors herein constitute one or more of the aforesaid twenty heirs of Fred Burgess Hemphill and Annie Hemphill.

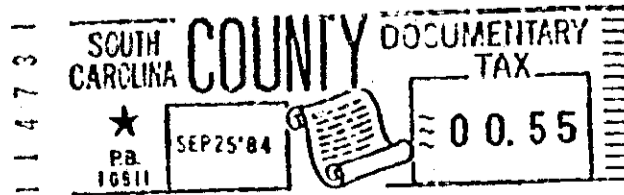
THIS property is conveyed subject to a 10 foot wide sewerline easement along the northerly side of Lot No. 83 and to such matters as would appear from a current resurvey.
