CANCELLATION OF LEASE

WHEREAS, the County of Greenville now owns the fee title to the Bell Tower Shopping Center property;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of \$59,000.00, the receipt whereof is acknowledged by Greenville County, the parties hereby agree that the lease between Bell Tower Shopping Center, Inc.
