In consideration of the sum of money hereinafter set out and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged from the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, the premises described herein, do hereby grant to the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, its successors, assigns, and affilied and associated companies, a right of way easement to, over, along, under, across, and through the premises and systems of communications or related services as the practice may require, including:

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- (2) buried cables and wires, cable terminals, markers, soling and pedestals;
- (3) conduits, manholes, markers, underground cables and wires;
- (4) and other amplifiers, boxes, apparatuses or devices.

All that certain piece, parcel, or tract of land bounded by lands of Margaret Jill Cox on the north, Anne C. Pearsons on the east, John H. Beckrodge, Jr. on the south, and American Service Corporation (Silverleaf Subdivision) on the west and known as River Downs Subdivision and described as Lot 30, Block 1 on Greenville County Tax Map 535.3. This property deeded to Heritage Homes, Inc., and recorded in Book 1077 Page 417 the twentieth day of April, 1978, in the Register of Mesne Conveyance Office of Greenville County. and, to the fullest extent the undersigned has the power to grant, at all, over, along and under the roads, streets or highways adjoining or through said property.

The following rights are also granted: to allow any other person or company to erect wires or lay cable or conduit within the right of way for communications or electric power transmission or distribution; ingress and egress to said premises at all times; to clear the land and keep it cleared of all trees, undergrowth or other obstructions within the easement area; to trim and cut and keep trimmed and cut all dead, weak, leaning or dangerous trees or limbs outside of the easement area which might interfere with or fall upon the lines or systems of communications or power transmission or distribution.
