

4. To institute, prosecute, defend, abandon, compromise, arbitrate, and dispose of legal, equitable, or administrative hearings, actions, suits, attachments, arrests, distresses, or other proceedings, or otherwise engaged in litigation involving me, my property, or any interest of mine;

5. To deal with Attorney's individual, or any fiduciary capacity, in buying and selling assets, in lending and borrowing money, and in all other transactions, irrespective of the occupancy by the same person of dual positions;

6. To insure my property against damage or loss and Attorney against liability with respect to third person;

C. Powers Relating to Custody of Person

1. In general, and in addition to all the specific acts in this section enumerated, to do any other act or acts, which I can do through an agent, for the preservation and maintenance of my personal relationships to relatives, friends, and organizations.

2. To continue the discharge of any services or duties assumed by me prior to the creation of this Power or thereafter, to any relative or friend of mine;

3. To supervise, compromise, enforce, arbitrate, defend, or settle any claim by or against me arising out of property damages or personal injuries suffered by or caused by me, or under such circumstances that the loss resulting therefrom will, or may fall on me; or to intervene in any action or proceeding relating thereto;
