(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged). have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said George C. Hindman, his heirs and assigns, forever;

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in

Township,

County, State of South Carolina, being shown as a 0.19 acre tract according to a survey for Rachel H. Wood prepared by R.B. Bruce, RLS, dated May 16, 1930, and revised August 15, 1934, said plat being recorded in Plat Book II-A at Page 24, in the RNC Office for Greenville County, S.C., and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin joint corner of a 0.72 acres tract owned by Rachel H. Wood, said pin lying on the northern corner 167.2 feet West of Poplar Street and running thence S. 73-45 E. 95 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 35-33 W. 138 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 56-47 W. 41.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 11-23 E. 118.6 feet to the point of beginning.
