

- (c) To sign, endorse, receive, deposit or issue checks, bonds, notes, stocks or other obligations or instruments, and to borrow money and secure the same in any manner;
- (d) To make deposits to and to make withdrawals from any accounts I may now or hereafter have with banks, savings and loan associations or other financial institutions, including but not limited to checking accounts, savings accounts, savings certificates and certificates of deposit;
- (e) To collect, sue for, settle, adjust or compromise any claim for money, arising by contract or tort, to execute releases, cancellations or satisfactions;
- (f) To do any other thing or perform any other act, not limited to the foregoing, which I might do in person, it being intended that this shall be a general power of attorney.

The purpose hereof is to grant to said Julian LeCraw this general power of attorney to deal with any property in which both of us (either alone or in conjunction with others) shall own or acquire an interest, including any new property in which both of us shall acquire an interest.

AND, I hereby give and grant to my said attorney-in-fact full power and authority to do and perform every act necessary, requisite or proper to be done in and about the premises as fully as I might or could do were I personally present, with full power of substitution and revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney-in-fact shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue hereof.

This Power of Attorney may be recorded on the records of Fulton County, Georgia, and on the public records at any other location, within or without the State of Georgia, and shall remain in full force and effect until the same is revoked by written instrument executed and recorded on the records of Fulton
