NOTICE OF MERGER

A certificate was issued today making effective, as of the close of business December 31, 1966, the merger of the First National Bank of Greer, Greer, South Carolina (Charter No. 14742), with common stock of \$150,000, into The Peoples National Bank of Greenville, Greenville, South Carolina (Charter No. 10635), with common stock of \$1,500,000. The merger was effected under the charter of The Peoples National Bank of Greenville and under the title "The Peoples National Bank," with capital stock of \$1,650,000, divided into 330,000 shares of common stock of the par value of \$5.00 each.

A certificate was also issued today authorizing the receiving association to operate the seven branches of The Peoples National Bank of Greenville and the one branch of the First National Bank of Greer which were authorized by this office since February 25, 1927.

A certificate was also issued today authorizing the receiving association to establish the following branch:

117 Trade Street, Greer, Greenville County,
South Carolina (present location of the head
office of the First National Bank of Greer),
to be known as "First National Bank Branch."
Certificate No. 1042A.

It is understood that the receiving association
and its branches will open for business on January 3, 1967.
