- 7. MAJORITY OF MEMBERS. As used in these by-laws, the term "majority of members" shall mean fifty-one (51%) percent or more of the residence owners and the presence in person or by proxy of a majority of members shall constitute a quorum.
- 8. PROXIES. Votes may be cast in person or by proxy. Proxies must be filed with the Secretary before the appointed time of each meeting.
- 9. MAJORITY VOTE. The vote of a majority of the members present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be binding upon all residence owners for all purposes except where a higher percentage is required by these by-laws or the Declaration.
- owned by more than one person or by a corporation or other entity shall be cast by the person named in a certificate signed by all of the owners of the residence or by the agent of such corporation or other entity, or by a general partner of a partnership, as the case may be, and filed with the Secretary of the Association. Such certificate shall be valid until revoked by a subsequent certificate. If such a certificate is not on file, the vote of such members shall not be considered in determining the requirement for a quorum for any other purpose.
- 11. PRESIDING OFFICER. The presiding officer at all meetings of members shall be President, in whose absence the Vice-President shall preside. If neither such officer is present, the members shall elect a chairman to preside at the particular meeting.
- 12. ORDER OF BUSINESS. The order of business at annual meetings of members, and, as far as practical at all other meetings of members, shall be:
 - a. Calling of the roll and certifying of proxies.
 - b. Proof of notice of meeting or waiver of notice.
 - c. Reading and disposal of any unapproved minutes.

- d. Reports of officers.
- e. Reports of committees.
- f: Election of directors.
- g. Unfinished business.
- h. New business.
- i. Adjournment.
